Recommended uses

Seedlings more easily controlled than mature plants
Use Autumn, early Winter or early Spring

Weeds controlled include:

Cereals

Black nightshade, seedling docks, fathen, shepherds purse, nettle, wild turnip, hedge mustard, redroot.

Pasture

Annual and perennial buttercups, hedge mustard, thistles, catsear, dandelion, nettle, plantains, twin cress, wild turnip, willow weed, hoary cress, creeping mallow, headland spear.

Also controlled

Bathhurst bur, burdock, daisy, field cress, fumitory, cut leaved geranium, hawkbit, mouse eared hawksweed, Onehunga weed, oxtounge, penny cress and water cress.

Application rates

Cereals: Use 1.5-3 L/ha and apply while weeds are at the 2-6 leaf stage and growing actively. Spray when the crop is between the 5 leaf stage and jointing. Do not use on cereal crops undersown with clovers.

Pasture: 3-4 L/ha for thistles, annual buttercups and hedge mustard.
4-6 L/ha for other weeds, see label for further information.

Livestock withholding

At least 2 weeks

Clovers

High rates may cause temporary suppression of clover
Graze area before spraying to reduce clover.
