EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or Leak	Wear overalls, chemical resistant gloves, boots and safety goggles. Prevent further spillage. Absorb spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water and detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container. Dispose of container according to the regulations of the local authority.
Fire	Call the Fire Department: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with water fog, foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. During a fire, toxic fumes may be released. Cool sealed drums with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	Do NOT induce vomiting. Immediately call a NATIONAL POISON CENTRE (0800 764 766) or doctor/physician. If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.
If in Eyes:	Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Call a Doctor or National Poison Centre 0800 764 766 for advice.
If on Skin:	If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do not scrub the skin.
If Inhaled:	Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. If symptoms develop call a Doctor or National Poison Centre 0800 764 766

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry, ventilated place away from direct heat or direct sunlight. Store away from foodstuffs, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use.
